The CVs are out of the data-base of CVs established in the Programme. The data-base is set up for Short Term Technical Assignments. But, of course, it can be consulted for whatever need you may have in searching out a particular expert.

To assist you in your search database includes two spread sheets. In one all the CVs are listed according to the main field of each consultant.
