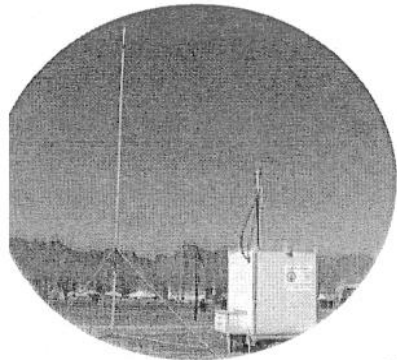



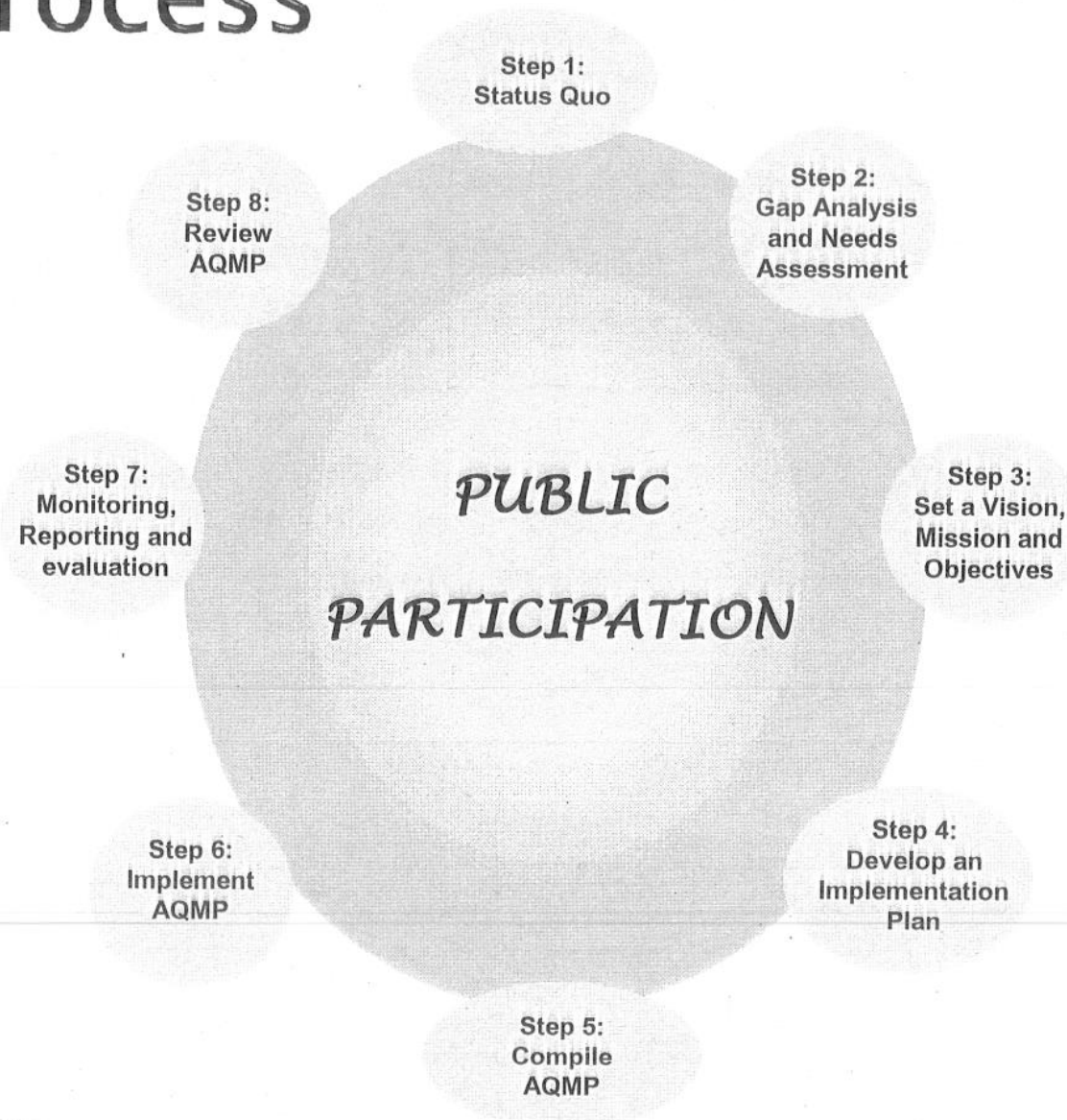

What is an Air Quality Management Plan?

- ▶ An AQMP is a plan that outlines all activities to be undertaken to assess, characterize, mitigate, implement, check and review the air quality within a specific area so as to ensure that air quality is in compliance with the National Environmental Management: Air Quality Act, Act 39 of 2004 (NEM: AQA).

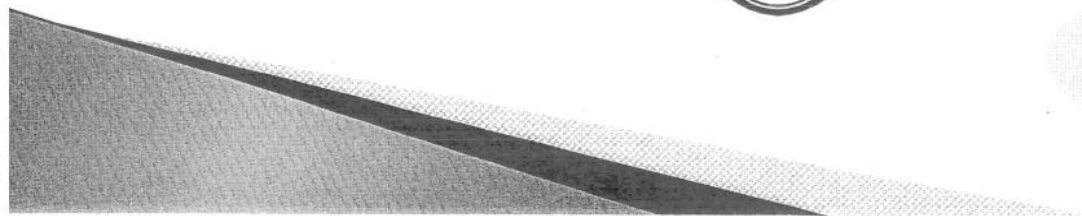

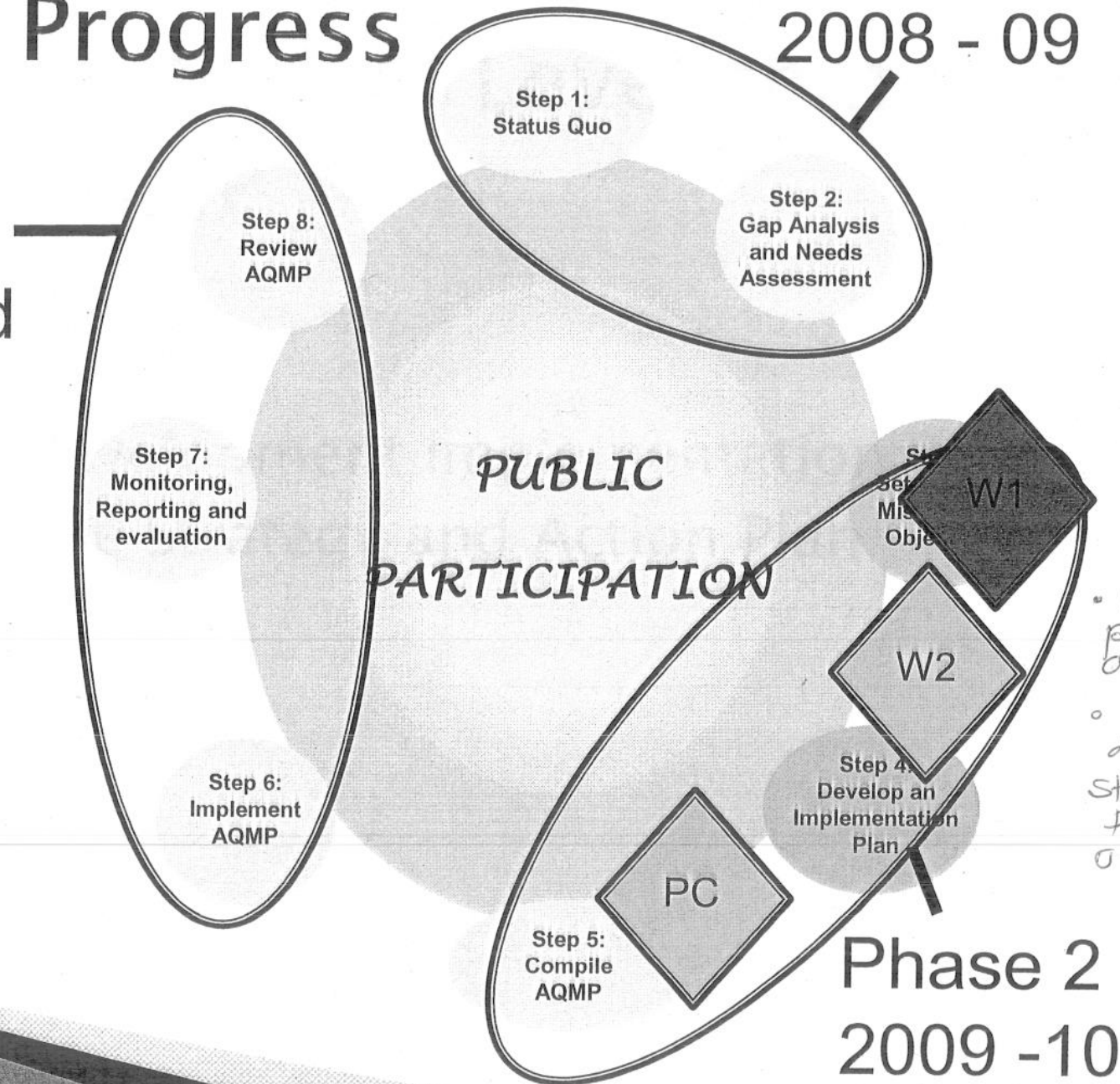



Implementation of the Provincial AQMP

- ▶ Published and launched the AQMP and Executive Summary documents in 2010.
 - ▶ Reprints have been distributed to Cape Metropole libraries and next phase will be to the rest of the provincial libraries.
 - ▶ Established 3 Working Group's – to facilitate implementation of the Provincial AQMP, meet on a quarterly basis.
 - ▶ Elected 3 Chairpersons to implement activities for these Working Groups.
 - ▶ Established a Steering Committee – Chairpersons of Working Groups report back biannually on progress made in their respective Working Groups.

Implementation of the Provincial AQMP

- ▶ Developed promotional awareness raising material – brochures which illustrate how to manage Air Quality in fishmeal, sawmill and tannery industries and air quality and climate change co-benefits.
 - ▶ Conducted visit to Oudsthoorn Local Municipality to discuss the development of the AQMP for their area and inclusion of the AQMP into their IDP.
 - ▶ 2011–2012 financial year:
 - conduct visits to Local Municipalities to engage with councillors and Municipal Managers to establish AQM units and appoint AQO's.
 - conduct 4 Working Group Meetings and 2 Steering Committee meetings.
